EXECUTIVE SUMMARY

King's Glory Primary School and Heritage Christian School are community-focused schools in Kamuli, Uganda. The schools seek responsible partners to strengthen education, nutrition, digital learning, scholarships and the learning environment.

Core donor priorities: Daily Feeding, Computer Literacy & Digital Learning, Scholarships, and Classrooms/Furniture/Learning Resources.

The school reports 500+ learners, 27 teachers and a scholarship target of 120 priority learners. These figures should be confirmed by the school before publication in a formal donor agreement.

DAILY FEEDING PROGRAM

\$1 can help feed 2 children. This is the school's campaign estimate and should be verified against current food prices and the approved feeding budget.

COMPUTER LITERACY & DIGITAL LEARNING

Indicative first-phase budget: UGX 65,000,000. Proposed for 20 student computers, display/projector, networking, power backup/solar support, furniture, teacher training, digital materials and maintenance. Target: 100 direct learners in Phase 1.

CLASSROOMS, FURNITURE & LEARNING RESOURCES

Final indicative project budget: UGX 150,000,000. This broader school-development package covers classroom improvement, desks/tables/chairs, books and teaching materials, water/sanitation improvements, electrical/lighting and safety improvements, and minor works/contingency.

HOW DONORS CAN CONTRIBUTE

IMPORTANT BUDGET NOTE

The UGX 65,000,000 and UGX 150,000,000 figures are **indicative planning budgets**. Final procurement should use current supplier quotations, school assessments and donor-approved scopes. The feeding conversion of \$1 for 2 children should likewise be checked against current food costs.
